ENTRANCE is an EU funded programme which considers how academics can integrate and build their students' entrepreneurship skills during their teaching regardless their academic discipline. Furthermore, it aims to reinforce the enterprising competencies of non-business academics and eventually of students in order to become self-employed, setting up new businesses (start-ups) or developing and growing part of an existing venture (e.g., spin off).
